

Academic Standards are statements that identify what students should know, understand, and be able to do in the classroom. Standards serve as goals for teaching and learning. Setting high standards enables students, parents, educators, and citizens to know what students should have learned at a given point in time. Once standards are identified, a curriculum is developed that helps students meet and go beyond the standards. Curriculum includes standards, benchmarks, instructional strategies, activities, resources, and assessments. The Dodgeville School District utilizes standards from one or several state and/or national organizations, including all or parts of the standards. The chart below indicates what set of standards each curricular area utilizes.

School boards are required to annually recognize what adopted academic standards are in effect for the school year. Further, districts are required to notify parents and guardians of the standards to be used for the upcoming school year prior to the start of the school. The Dodgeville School District has adopted the follow
