## News From DMS - August / September 2024

Welcome to the 2024-25 school year. As we embark on another exciting school year, we wanted to share some information with all of you so we can start the school year off in a positive way which allows ALL students to be successful. We have had some late changes this year

#### **Bussing Changes This School Year**

Drop Off- For drop off in the morning this year we are going to take a similar approach to that which we have taken at the end of the day. All vehicles (buses and Student dropoff vehicles) will use the first lane nearest the building. You will pull up all the way to the end of the line by the baseball diamond and we will mass drop off students this year so drop off vehicles will not be backed up, restricting the flow of traffic. This way multiple students can be dropped off at once compared to one or two carloads at a time. It is important that buses and cars alike pull up to the very end of the drop off line.

Pick up- Any vehicles that are picking up students should not line up until 3:18. Blocking of traffic by turning left will no longer be permitted. The only waiting cars on the road should be pulled over on the right hand side, and should only be turning right into our parking lot so we don't block any flow of traffic.

#### Schedule

The big changes this year are for 6th-8th grade students who will have alternating A/B days this school year. They will have 40 or 80 minutes of instruction those days for Math and ELA Instruction. The total will average 60 minutes of ELA and Math instruction which is the same as last year with a different scheduling approach.

We also have a dedicated intervention block for all students. This time will be used to reteach essential standards that students haven't grasped yet or will be used to extend student learning if they have..

#### **Open House**

Open house is a great opportunity to visit your children's classroom, put things in their lockers, meet their teachers for the school year, and orient themselves to room changes that have occurred for teachers over the summer. We look forward to seeing everyone again and getting the 2024-25 school year started out on the right foot.
