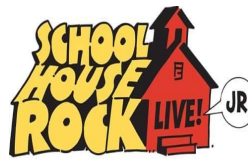
LOST & FOUND

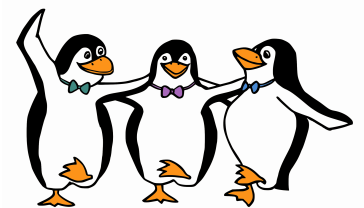

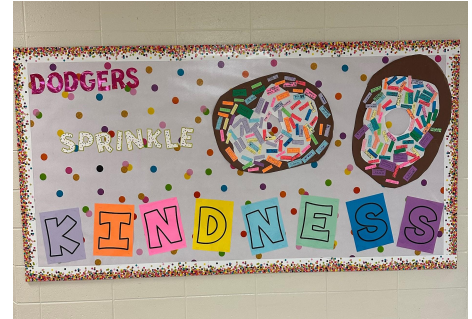

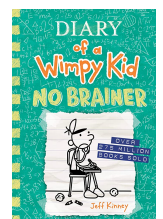
Experiment series. *Just Keep Walking* is her newest release and is also Erin's favorite book yet!

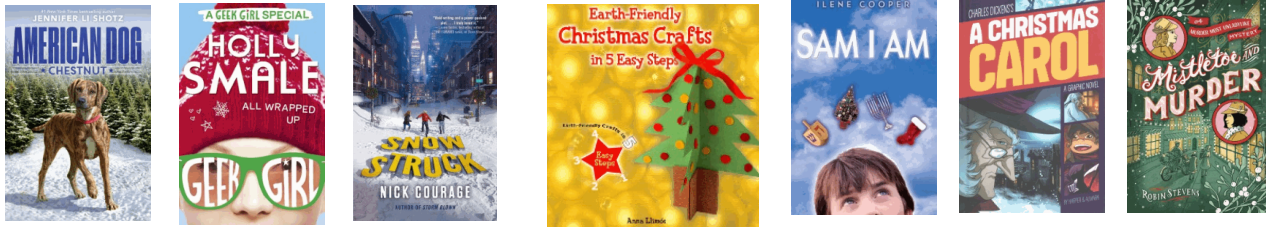

WINTER CONCERTS

~ PHYSICAL EDUCATION ~

DANCE & 6th-Grade

I am so proud of the 6th-grade students. I'm impressed with how hard they work during the dance unit. They definitely get the heart rate up.

Students demonstrated the correct rhythm and pattern for several different dances: line, partner, and folk. They also collaborated with their small group to modify a dance sequence to make it their own!

These kids are really talented and creative. The dances are amazing and when they add the big finish in, well, that's the icing on the cake! I want to thank all the 6th-grade students for making this unit so fun!

WOD! AMRAP!

The above are acronyms used in some fitness circles. WOD stands for the workout of the day. AMRAP is As Many Reps/Rounds As Possible.

On Mondays, 6-8th grade physical education students are challenged to complete a short WOD.

The WOD for the second quarter allows students to select 3-4 exercises from a list of 8. Students complete 5 repetitions of their chosen exercises and then run 1 lap.

Students are challenged to complete as many rounds as possible (AMRAP) in 2 minutes.

Many students have really dug deep to go further each time. It's exciting to see students beat their previous personal best! Some students create a very difficult WOD based on their exercise selection. Great work by all students creating their own WOD and putting in their best effort.

The next challenge comes in the second semester when the WOD time increases to 3 minutes.

PE Gear & PE Lockers and Locks

What is PE gear?

PE gear is appropriate clothing and shoes for participation in physical education class activities.

PE gear means different clothes from what is worn to school. Students change into those clothes for PE class and then out of them, at the end of class, and back into their school day clothes.

Proper shoes can be any type of clean sneaker or tennis shoe that is safe. Students do not need designated PE shoes. Tennis shoes worn to school may be used in PE. Crocs, slides, shoes with heels, and shoes other than tennis shoes are a safety issue in PE and should not be worn in class. We do have a large selection of appropriate shoes that have been donated that students may borrow for PE class.

7th and 8th-grade students have had the expectation to change for class. During the second semester, 6th-grade students will also be expected to change for PE class.

Students have the option to bring their PE gear on a daily basis or to store their PE gear in a locker in the locker room. Students may request a locker and school-issued lock if they want to use a locker for storage versus their backpack.

Second Semester (Jan. 2024) Physical Education with Ms. Day-Nelson

6th-grade PE students with Ms. Day-Nelson will participate in two units: Base Games & Frisbee Skills. The base games unit will allow students to explore a variety of unique games that involve base running, cooperation, and strategy. The Frisbee skills unit will work on targeting and disc skills. They will learn and attempt several throws. Students are asked to give some different catches a try. There will also be a few targeting challenges and competitions.

7th-grade PE students with Ms. Day-Nelson will get to play Nitroball as their first unit. Nitroball is a game sometimes called upside-down or inverted volleyball. The game is played with a 3-foot net and the ball must bounce before being played. Nitroball will help students work on 3 contact team play as they transition into the volleyball skills unit. In the volleyball unit, students will focus on basic skills and then be challenged to use those skills in game-like drills.

8th-grade PE students with Ms. Day-Nelson will roll out the mat for some stretching and breathwork in the Yoga unit. The focus is on Yoga movements for fitness and the importance of breathwork for focus and calming the mind. Students will get to experience short guided relaxation and mindfulness exercises. The students will also get to play large group net games like Eclipse and Oval Ball, where cooperation, communication, and fun are key to success.

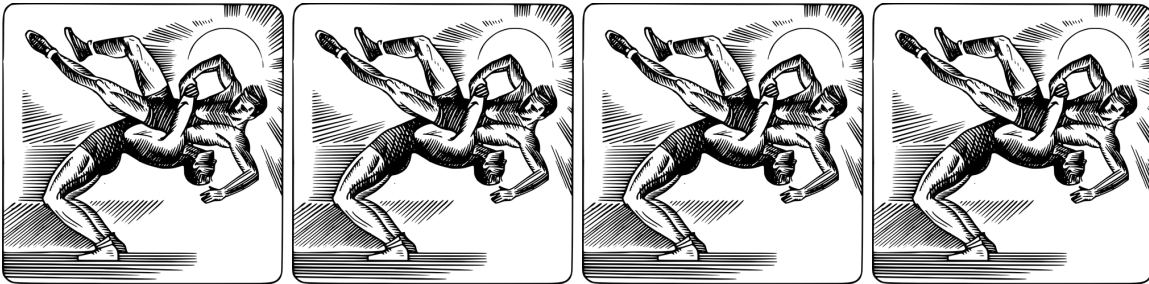
