Driver Education Theory Program Requirements:

1. Create a student account using the SWTC Continuing Education site: <u>https://swtc.augusoft.net.</u>

Student information and email must be the student taking the class.

If you need help, there is a Need help link on the left side of the continuing education website.

- a. Student registers prior to first day of class. Link/URL will be provided by your instructor
- b. Login to the continuing education student account
- c. Use the link provided <u>Driver Education Theory SWTC Continuing Education</u>8:00 10:00 <u>Driver Education Theory - SWTC Continuing Education</u>10:00 - 12:00 to register for the class with your school.

If you are registering for the online theory course, select Traffic Safety – Driver Education on the left of the screen and follow the following steps

- d. Add to cart
- e. Complete the Driver Education Contact Information form
- f. View cart/Checkout in the upper right of screen
- g. Follow the instructions and agree to the policies and checkout to finish registration
- h. Pay the \$130 Drivers Education Theory class fee
- i. Receive a registration confirmation email
- 2. Once you have completed and passed the Driver Education Theory, your instructor will provide a behind the wheel link. Mr. Riechers will distribute the permit applications once you have registered and paid for behind the wheel. (See the behind the wheel document for instructions)
