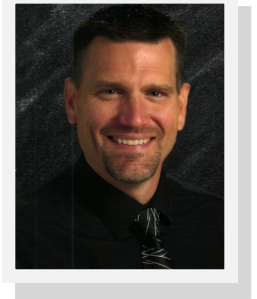

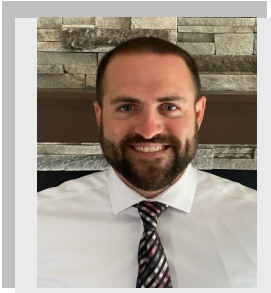


Construction Class Help with Soccer Goals

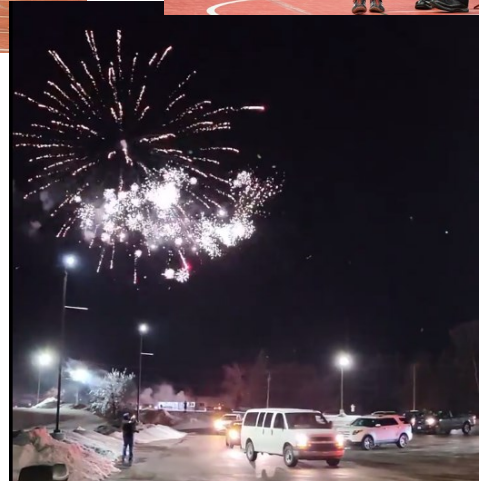
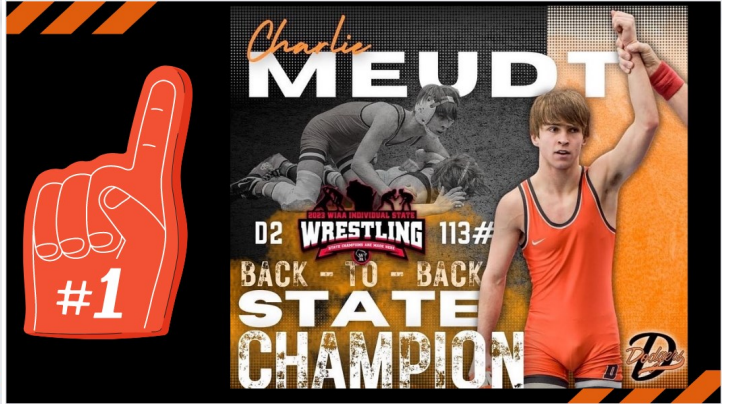
DECA is going to Orlando!
