

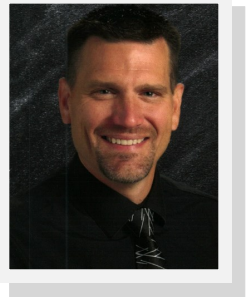

Remember to always stop for a bus with their flashing lights on signifying students are getting on or off.

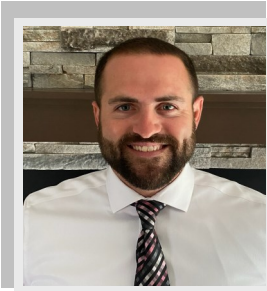

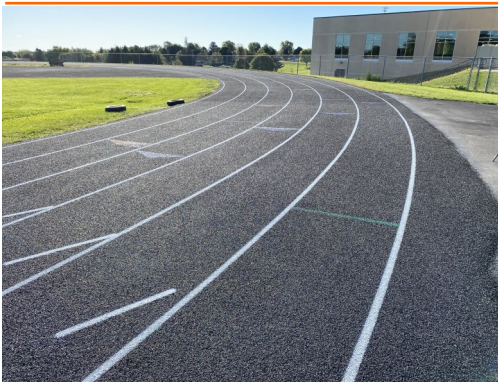
From Mr Martin, AD/Dean of Students

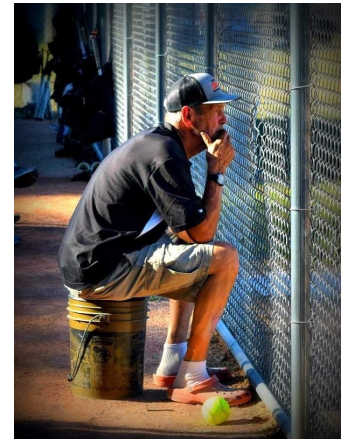
